GENERAL INFORMATION

A Community Aged Care Package (CACP) is a planned and coordinated program of community care services individually designed to assist people with complex care needs, who are eligible for hostel care but choose to remain in their own homes. Eligibility is assessed by a member of the Aged Care Assessment Team.

Community Aged Care Packages are available to assist any eligible person who requires assistance relating to:

- Case Management
- Showering/Bathing
- Dressing/Undressing
- Mobility/Transfer/Transport
- Meals (provision & preparing)
- Laundry / Light Housework
- Monitoring Medications
- In-Home Respite
- Socialisation
- Minor Home Maintenance

Cost

An affordable fee for service applies. This fee is 17.5% of the single maximum pension excluding rental assistance and pharmaceutical allowance. The CACP Coordinator will discuss this with you at the initial interview.
