GENERAL INFORMATION

An Extended Aged Care at Home Package (EACH) is a planned and coordinated program of community care services designed to assist people with complex care needs, who are eligible for nursing home care, but choose to remain at home. Eligibility is assessed by a member of the Aged Care Assessment Team.

Extended Aged Care at Home Packages are available to assist any eligible person who requires assistance relating to:

- Case Management
- Personal Care
- Medications/Treatments
- Nutrition
- Continence Management
- Behaviour/Cognition
- Social Support
- Home Modifications
- Domestic Assistance
- Complex Nursing
- Therapy Program
- Mobility/Transfer
- Communication
- Meals Assistance

Cost

An affordable fee for service applies. This fee is 17.5% of the single maximum pension excluding rental assistance and pharmaceutical allowance.
